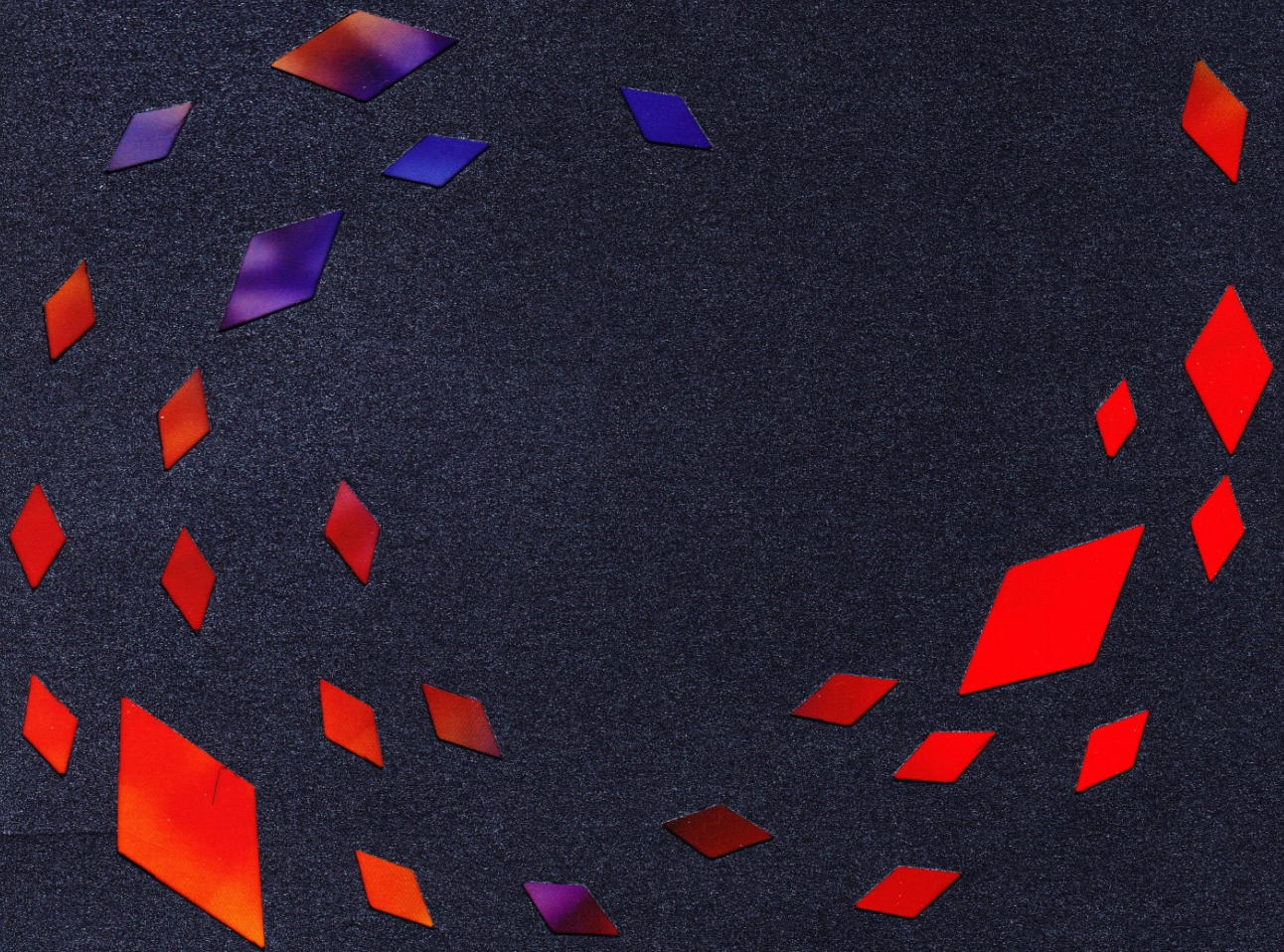

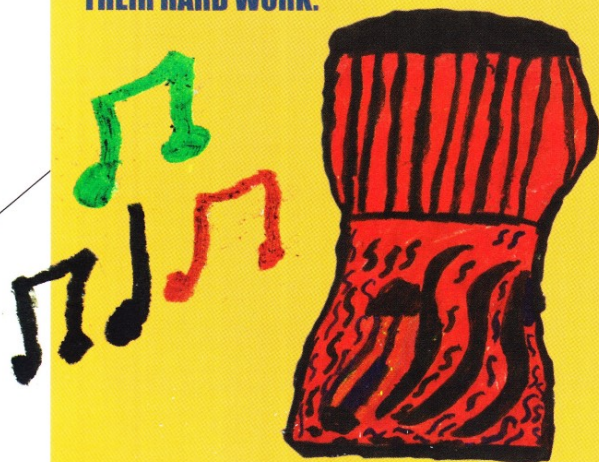


# ARTISTIC VISION FOR THE ROYAL VISIT

## **'DIAMONDS, FEATHERS AND SAXOPHONES' A FANFARE FROM THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL**

A PIECE OF MUSIC WAS SPECIALLY COMMISSIONED FOR THE ROYAL VISIT, PERFORMED AT THE EVENT BY ABSOLUTION SAXOPHONE QUARTET. COMPOSER STEVEN JACKSON, FROM THE ROYAL NORTHERN COLLEGE OF MUSIC, WAS INSPIRED BY CREATIVE IDEAS EXPLORED IN A WORKSHOP WITH CHILDREN, SUPPORTED BY THEIR PARENTS AND PLAY SPECIALISTS, AT THE ROYAL MANCHESTER CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL.

THE COMPOSER INCORPORATED ELEMENTS FROM CHILDREN INTO HIS COMPOSITION INCLUDING: JAMIE'S RHYTHMS ON A FOOTBALLER'S NAME, JUDY'S INTRICATE GRAPHIC SCORES, MOASSAB'S BIG COLOURFUL PAINTINGS, PIATR'S SLOW, GENTLE PATTERNS ON THUMB-PIANO, MEGAN'S CONTRASTING SHAKERS AND LARA'S 'AWESOME MUSIK' SCULPTURE.

MUSIC FOR HEALTH BASED AT RNCM BRINGS MUSIC TO THE CENTRAL MANCHESTER HOSPITALS, SENSITIVELY SHARING AND CREATING MUSIC WITH PATIENTS, STAFF AND VISITORS. MUSIC FOR HEALTH ALSO DELIVERS CONCERTS, RESIDENCIES AND TRAINING FOR MUSICIANS AND HEALTHCARE STAFF.





## THE BESPOKE HANDMADE SCORE

THE MUSICAL FANFARE 'DIAMONDS, FEATHERS AND SAXOPHONES' WAS PRESENTED TO HER MAJESTY IN A BEAUTIFUL, SPECIALLY COMMISSIONED HANDMADE BOOK – A UNIQUE AND PERSONAL GIFT FROM THE TRUST.

GRAPHIC ARTIST DAWN PRESCOTT FROM LIME IN COLLABORATION WITH ANDREW BROWN, MASTER CRAFTSMAN AT THE ARTISAN BINDERY DESIGNED AND PRODUCED THIS EXCEPTIONAL GIFT. BOUND IN DEEP MAJESTIC BLUE LEATHER. THE DESIGN INCLUDES A SAXOPHONE OF BEAUTIFUL FUSED COLOURS, A FLURRY OF GOLD AND SILVER FOIL DIAMONDS AND TINY EMBOSSED COLOURFUL FEATHERS. NESTLED AT A VERY CENTRAL POINT OF THE DESIGN IS THE OUTLINE OF A BEE, ITS WINGS, IN DELICATE SILVER LINES EXTEND ACROSS THE ENTIRE

BOOK COVER. THE BEE, A SYMBOL ASSOCIATED WITH MANCHESTER DURING THE 19TH CENTURY, DENOTES MANCUNIANS' HARD WORK DURING THIS ERA AND MANCHESTER BEING A HIVE OF ACTIVITY.

TWO COPIES OF THIS EXQUISITE BOOK WERE PRODUCED SO THAT ONE COULD BE SHARED WITH VISITORS TO THE HOSPITALS AND STAFF. THE BOOK WILL BE DISPLAYED IN DIFFERENT LOCATIONS THROUGHTOUT THE ORGANISATION.

LIME ART BASED AT THE TRUST WORKS WITHIN HEALTHCARE ACROSS GREATER MANCHESTER. DELIVERING A WIDE RANGE OF ARTISTIC PROJECTS, LIME AIMS TO USE THE ARTS TO ENHANCE PATIENTS, STAFF AND VISITORS QUALITY OF LIFE AND CARE WITHIN THE HOSPITAL SETTING.

THE DISPLAY IS MADE UP OF PHOTOGRAPHS OF CHILDREN WHO ARE IN-PATIENTS AT ROYAL MANCHESTER CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL (RMCH). THESE SHOTS ARE LINKED WITH IMAGES CELEBRATING THE QUEEN'S DIAMOND JUBILEE YEAR. THESE PICTURES WERE CREATED BY RMCH PATIENTS OF ALL AGES, WITH HELP FROM THERAPEUTIC AND SPECIALISED PLAY SERVICE MANAGER SUSAN FAIRCLOUGH AND HER TEAM. PAINT BLOTS, PENCILS AND SPECIALLY DESIGNED SYMBOLS THAT ASSIST CHILDREN WITH LEARNING DIFFICULTIES WERE ALSO ADDED.

## PLAQUES BY GLASS ARTIST MARTIN DONLIN

LIME WORKED WITH GLASS ARTIST MARTIN DONLIN TO PRODUCE FOUR PLAQUES. BELOW THE ARTIST EXPLAINS HIS WORK.

"THE FOUR PLAQUE DESIGNS HAVE BEEN DEVELOPED FROM TWO MAIN INFLUENCES IN EACH; FIRST THE COLOUR THAT REPRESENTS THE PARTICULAR HOSPITAL AND SECONDLY THE 'CUT' OF EACH DIAMOND THAT REFRACTS THE COLOUR. ALL DIAMONDS ARE CUT DIFFERENTLY BUT A NUMBER OF DIAMOND CUTS HAVE BEEN DEVELOPED THAT GREATLY IMPACT ON THE BRILLIANCE OF THE STONE.

IN THE DESIGNS THE SHAPES AND FORMS OF THE DIAMONDS HAVE BEEN ABSTRACTED TO SUCH A DEGREE TO CREATE A NUMBER OF TONES AND TEXTURES WITHIN THE DESIGNS, THE DIAMOND 'CUTS' THAT HAVE INFLUENCED THE DESIGNS ARE AS FOLLOWS: THE MANCHESTER ROYAL INFIRMARY HAS A MAJESTIC 'CROWN LIKE' 'ROUND CUT'. THE EYE HOSPITAL IS A 'MARQUISE CUT' - SIMILAR TO THE SHAPE OF AN EYE. SAINT MARY'S IS A VIBRANT AND REGAL 'RADIANT CUT'. THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL HAS A 'CUSHION CUT' - 'SOFT FEATHER LIKE AND LIGHTWEIGHT.'

# A LEADING ORGANISATION

**MANCHESTER ROYAL INFIRMARY** is a large teaching hospital and a specialist regional centre for kidney and pancreas transplants, cardiology and cardiothoracic surgery. We have boasted many medical breakthroughs, including, the first hospital in the UK to undertake 4,000 kidney transplants, the first to have undertaken 1,000 cochlear implants and more recently the first in the UK to use a standalone 3D system for prostate cancer surgery.

**THE MANCHESTER ROYAL EYE HOSPITAL** is one of the largest teaching eye hospitals in Europe and one of only two dedicated eye hospitals in the country. Globally acknowledged as a centre of excellence, the Eye Hospital is renowned for its pioneering work in all aspects of ophthalmology, including the Emergency Eye Centre, Acute Referral Centre, Ophthalmic Imaging, Ultrasound Unit, Electrodiagnosis, Laser Unit, Optometry, Orthoptics, Manchester Eye Bank, Ocular Prosthetics and the bionic eye implant trial.

**SAINT MARY'S HOSPITAL** has successfully developed a wide range of world class medical services for women and babies as well as a comprehensive Genetics Centre. We now deliver over 7,000 babies each year. There are 1,000 staff who provide the highest standards of care in: Obstetrics/Maternity; Gynaecology; Genetics and Newborn Intensive Care.

**THE ROYAL MANCHESTER CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL** provides specialist healthcare services for children and young people. We see 185,000 patients each year across a range of specialties including oncology, haematology, bone marrow transplant, burns, genetics, and orthopaedics. With 371 beds it is the largest single-site children's hospital in the UK.



## TRAFFORD HOSPITALS

From 1st April 2012 the three hospitals (Trafford General, Altrincham and Stretford Memorial) are now under the management of our organisation following a successful acquisition process. Services include general surgery and medicine; children's services; cardiology; orthopaedics; audiology; elderly care; dermatology; respiratory; and Ear, nose and throat.

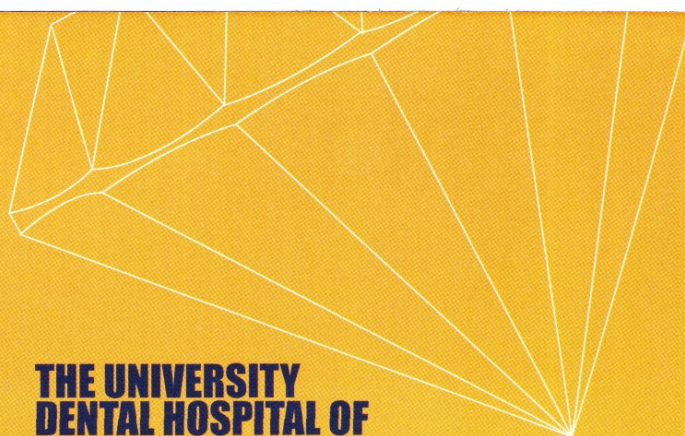
We also manage 45 **community services** including Adult Services like District Nursing, Continence and Podiatry for the central Manchester area, along with Children's services, Contraception and Sexual Health, Community Dentistry, and Learning Disabilities services for the whole of the city.

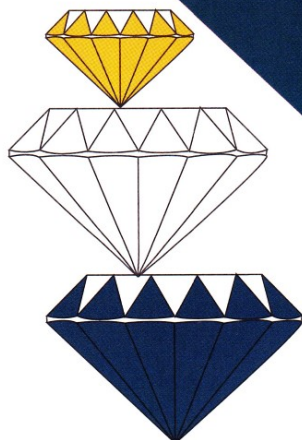

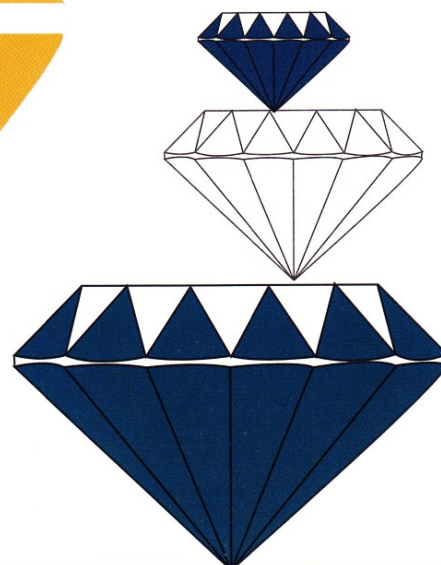

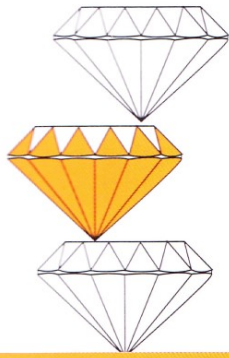


## **MANCHESTER ROYAL INFIRMARY**

in the last 40 years.

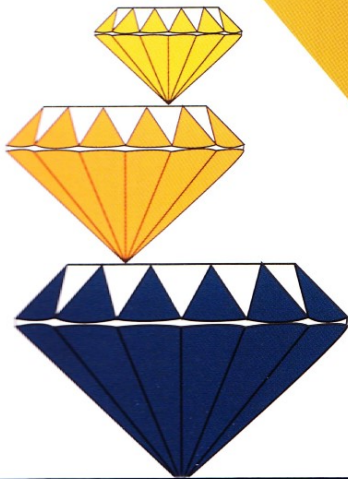






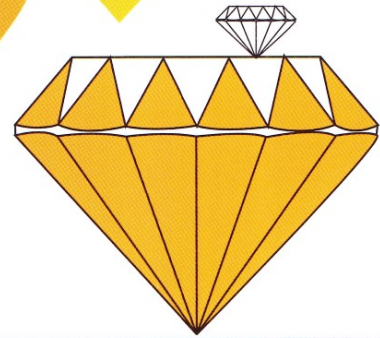
## **ROYAL MANCHESTER CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL**

The Paediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU) is one of the leading centres in the North West and the largest general PICU in the UK.



## **SAINT MARY'S HOSPITAL**

Delivers over 7,000 babies each year. Has the only Genetics service in the Region. Has the only surgical centre for new born babies in the Region. Was the first to have a NHS IVF unit in the country. Our Saint Mary's Centre was the first Sexual Assault Referral Centre to be launched in the country.



## **MANCHESTER ROYAL EYE HOSPITAL**

Is one of the largest eye teaching hospitals in Europe. Undertakes around 10,000 cataract procedures each year. Is one of only two centres in the UK to take part in the Bionic Eye trial, with only 32 patients taking part worldwide.
